



## PREPARATION REQUIREMENTS CONVENTIONAL INTESTINAL TRANSIT



### ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS AND APPOINTMENT SCHEDULING

1. Medical order with information about the test to be performed.
2. Authorization from the insurance company.
3. Identification document and insurance card (if applicable).
4. If the patient is (think is) pregnant, immediately notify the radiology personnel.
5. During the last eight (8) days you should NOT have had any studies performed using barium as a contrast medium.

### EXAM DURATION:

Approximately 1-6 hour(s).

### ONE DAY BEFORE THE EXAM:

For lunch and dinner have non-fat foods. Do not consume eggs. It can be ground or roast beef, mashed potatoes and/or pasta soup.

### ON EXAM DAY:

1. Fasting necessary:
  - Patients under 3 years old: 3-hour fast.
  - Patients aged 3-12 years old: 4-hour fast.
  - Patients over 12 years old: 6-hour fast.
2. If the patient is aged under 10 years, bring two adult (non-pregnant) companions.
3. For patients taking baby bottle, bring two baby bottles: one empty and one with the liquid of preference.
4. If you take control medicines for hypertension and/or diabetes, take them with little water. DO NOT SUSPEND.
5. Bring related previous radiological studies.
6. Arrive 20 minutes before the exam time.
7. Do not bring jewelry, money or valuables. CediMed is not responsible for any loss or theft of your belongings.
