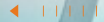




*PREPARATION REQUIREMENTS  
LABELED RED BLOOD CELL SCINTIGRAPHY,  
GASTROINTESTINAL BLEEDING, BLOOD POOL.*



## **INDICATIONS**

Location of gastrointestinal bleeding (gastrointestinal bleeding under the fundus, duodenal bleeding and in the distal sections of the intestine). For the evaluation of hemangioma and accessory spleen in patients already splenectomized. It is also done with red blood cells but the duration of the test is different. Detection of gastrointestinal bleeding.

## **ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS AND APPOINTMENT SCHEDULING**

1. Medical order with information about the test to be performed.
2. Authorization from the insurance company.
3. Identification document and insurance card (if applicable).
4. Bring previous radiological studies (scintigraphy).
5. If the patient is (think is) pregnant, inform immediately the radiology personnel.

## **EXAM DURATION:**

For hemangioma and accessory spleen: approximately 6 hours.

For gastrointestinal bleeding: approximately 9 hours on the first day and with the possibility of imaging 24 hours later (5 minutes).

## **ON EXAM DAY:**

1. 6-hour fast.
2. Bring related previous radiological studies.
3. Do not bring jewelry, money or valuables. CediMed is not responsible for any loss or theft of your belongings.
