



PREPARATION REQUIREMENTS SCINTIGRAPHY WITH DTPA GFR AND/OR LASIX



INDICATIONS

- Diagnosis of renovascular hypertension.
- Diagnosis of obstructive uropathy.
- Hydronephrosis
- Renal trauma.
- Transplant evaluation.
- Congenital malformation.
- Nephrolithiasis.
- Assess renal filtration and ureteropelvic junction obstruction.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS AND APPOINTMENT SCHEDULING

1. Medical order with information about the test to be performed.
2. Authorization from the insurance company.
3. Identification document and insurance card (if applicable).
4. If the patient is (think is) pregnant, inform immediately the radiology personnel.
5. If patients are hospitalized, they should have a venous access with 250cc serum. If they are children, they should bring urinary catheter.
6. Bring the result of urine culture with a negative result not exceeding eight days (only for children under 10 years).

EXAM DURATION:

Approximately 25-50 minutes, depending on the hydration condition of the patient.

ON EXAM DAY:

Adults

1. Take 6-8 glasses of water 30 minutes before the procedure, you can eliminate (urinate).
2. Bring related previous radiological studies.
3. Bring creatinine test results (if available).

Children

1. Not presenting febrile state 48 hours before the procedure.
2. Not presenting urinary infection (active).
