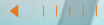




PREPARATION REQUIREMENTS THREE-PHASE BONE SCINTIGRAPHY



INDICATION:

- Secondary bone cancer.
- Osteomyelitis.
- Sacroiliitis.
- Renal osteodystrophy.
- Back pain or other location of unknown cause.
- Stress fracture.
- Trauma.
- Algoneurodystrophy. Aseptic osteonecrosis.
- Study of the epiphyseal plate (epiphyseal disorders).
- Shaken baby syndrome.
- Bone infarcts (SCD).
- Paget's disease.
- Evaluation of infectious, inflammatory or posttraumatic processes.
- Bone vascular function.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS AND APPOINTMENT SCHEDULING

1. Medical order with information about the test to be performed.
2. Authorization from the insurance company.
3. Identification document and insurance card (if applicable).
4. If the patient is (think is) pregnant, inform immediately the nuclear medicine personnel.
5. During the last eight (8) days you should NOT have had any studies performed using barium as a contrast medium.
6. Hospitalized patients must come with a Venous access.

EXAM DURATION:

1. After supplying the radiopharmaceutical consume 6 glasses of water or liquid of your choice and urinate.
2. After the application of the radiopharmaceutical, the patient must return at the time assigned by the technologist - approximately 2-5 hours after injection.

ON EXAM DAY:

1. Bring related previous radiological studies.
2. Do not bring jewelry, money or valuables. CediMed is not responsible for any loss or theft of your belongings.

AFTERCARE:

- Do not attend public places and do not stand in queues.
- Sleep alone.
- Take plenty of fluids for 24 hours.
- Do not have contact with children or pregnant women for 24 hours.
